

PAINT-SCRAPED FLAMINGOS



Materials Needed:

- Blue cardstock
- Black and white flamingo drawing
- Pink, red, and white paint
- Small, flat piece of cardboard (credit card sized)
- Black marker
- Glue stick
- Pink, white, and green construction paper
- Scissors

Instructions:

- Drip small lines of pink, white, and red paint lightly all over your flamingo picture, using more pink than the other colors.
- Use the flat piece of cardboard to push around the paint, so that it's flat all the way across. The colors should mix and make different shades of pink. Make sure the paint isn't gloopy.
- When your flamingo is dry, Cut out the flamingo body.
- Color a beak and make a black dot for the eye.
- Make two long legs by cutting out thin strips of pink paper (or, you can use white paper, and color it pink). If you want one of your flamingo's legs to be bent, you can cut it that way instead of straight.
- Glue flat strips of white and green paper (or any color combination you want!) to make the ground.
- Glue down the legs, and then glue your flamingo on top.
