

# Adult Takeaway Craft: Woven Bookmark

## SUPPLIES

### Included

- Plastic Needle
- 6 inch Ruler
- Yarn for warp (thinner yarn)
- Yarn for weave (8 bundles)

### Not included

- Pencil
- Scissors
- Tape
- Fork (optional)

## DIRECTIONS

1. Pencil a line about 2 inches down from each end of the loom
2. Add the thinner yarn to your loom, wrap vertically in all one piece, wrapping around the loom one piece per opening
3. Leave a tail at each end, and tape down on the opposite side from the pencil marks
4. At the bottom, use the ruler to go over then under each string, aligning the top with the pencil mark
5. Thread the needle with the yarn, and weave through above the ruler
6. Pull the yarn all the way through, leaving a tail
7. Remove the ruler, and push the yarn down to line up with the pencil line (a fork may make this easier)
8. Going from left to right now weave your yarn over/under with the ruler using the opposite strings
9. Follow with your needle of yarn
10. Remove the ruler, and push the string down to align with your first row
11. Do not pull the yarn too tight, you want the vertical strings to stay even. They should not bow inward
12. Repeat until the string on the needle runs out, leave a 2 inch tail at the end
13. Start with a new color and repeat steps 5 through 13
14. **\*Alternatively, you can leave the ruler inserted at the bottom as a way to keep the yarn rows from moving down too far, or bowing, and use the needle to weave under and over the strings**
15. Repeat steps 5 through 14 for each successive color of yarn
16. When you have finished all yarn, knot the ends along the edges
17. **\* If you have yarn at home, before you cut the warp threads, you could create a second bookmark on the other side using the same method**
18. Cut the warp threads at the top of the loom to free your bookmark from it and knot those
19. Flip the freed bookmark over, and using the needle weave the ends in to secure them.
20. Trim excess ends once secure.
