**SECTION 19 – AIRCRAFT AND VEHICULAR PARKING POLICY**

1.0 In order to better serve the traveling public during the busy summer season, the day before Memorial Day to the day following Columbus Day, the following policy is effective immediately and will remain in effect until further notice:

- 1.1 The terminal ramp is for transient aircraft parking. Aircraft that is owned/leased/operated or maintained by any FBO shall not be parked on the ramp for more than four (4) hours between the hours of 0800 and 1700.
- 1.2 At the discretion of the Airport Manager, each FBO may be allowed to park one (1) aircraft that it owns/leases/operates or maintains on the terminal ramp in exception to 1.1.
- 1.3 FBO's shall take measures to prevent their aircraft, and that of their customers, from impeding transient aircraft parking.
- 1.4 Customers requiring parking space longer than 8 hours should be directed by the FBO's to the Itinerant Parking Apron, east of the terminal.

2.0 Parking on the Itinerant Apron is limited to five (5) days.

3.0 Parking on the Terminal Apron two days after Columbus Day and two days before Memorial Day is limited to three (3) days.

4.0 As a courtesy to the traveling public, the westerly side of the parking lot is hereby designated as the staff parking area. This is also the designated long-term parking area. Parking in front of the terminal building is prohibited.

5.0 Rental cars shall be parked in their designated areas along the northerly side of the parking lot bordering Aviation Drive. Those rental agencies not having a designated parking area shall utilize the westerly portion of the parking lot.
