


Children's Book Awards



Ladybug Picture Book Award is designed to promote early literacy and honor the best in recent children's picture books. A committee of children's librarians from around the state selects 10 picture book titles then, New Hampshire children from preschoolers to those in third grade choose the award winner.

Great Stone Face Book Award is given annually to an author whose book receives the most votes from 4th through 6th graders throughout the State.


Digital Resources

1000 Books Before Kindergarten

The concept is simple, the rewards are priceless! Read any book (even repeats) to your newborn, infant, and/or toddler. The goal is to have read 1,000 books before your precious one starts kindergarten. If you read just 1 book a night, you will have read about 365 books in a year. That is 730 books in two years and 1,095 books in three years. Feel free to keep a record of any book that is being read to your child including by teachers and siblings.

STEM Kits

Did you know the Children's Room has STEM kits you can borrow? Check out one of these interactive kits for some fun hands-on learning!
